Is like to that above.

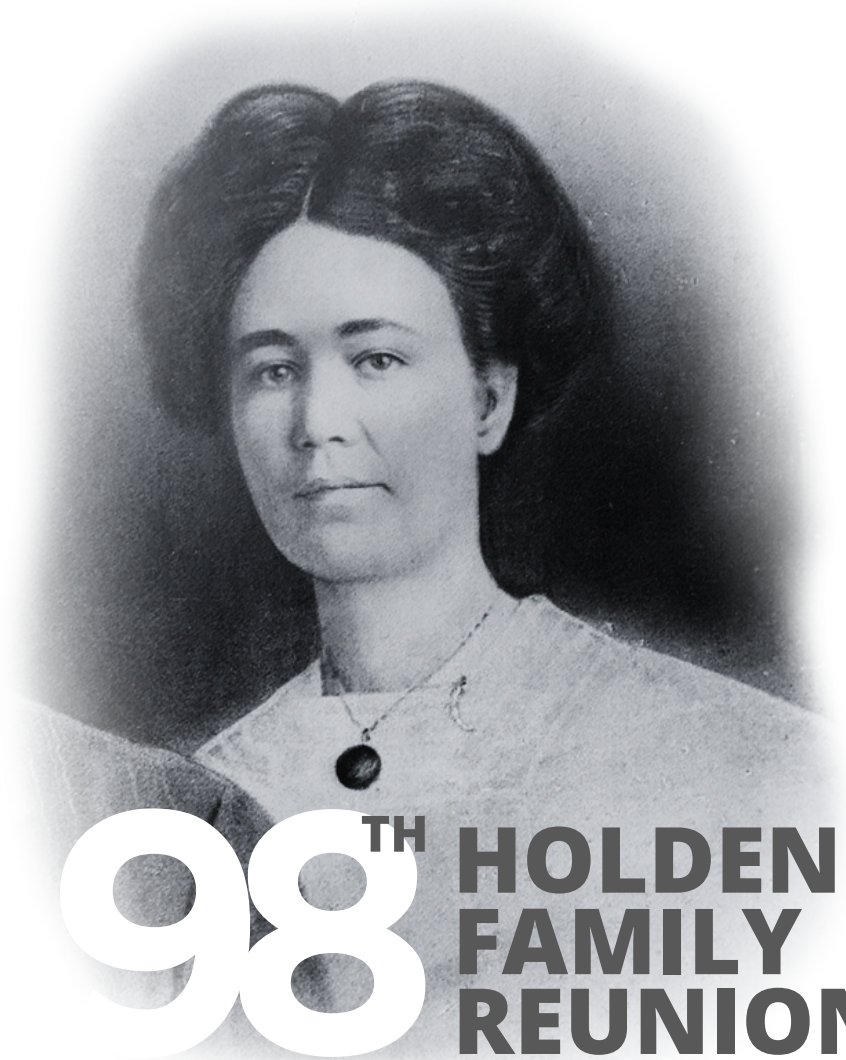
Before our Father's throne
